Housing Society Appoints New Chief Executive Officer

The Hong Kong Housing Society (HS) announced the appointment of Mr Wong Kit-loong as the Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director with effect from 1 April 2009, succeeding Miss Wong Lai-chun who has just retired.

Mr Wong joined the Society in 1994 responsible for property management duties. He was promoted to Director (Property Management) in 2001 and was appointed Deputy Chief Executive Officer in August 2008.

HS Chairman Mr Yeung Ka-sing said, "The Executive Committee has planned for the succession of Miss Wong upon her retirement. Having served in the Housing Society for many years, Mr Wong has a thorough understanding of the organization culture and business operations. I am confident that he would lead all staff to carry on with its social mission."

Having graduated from The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Mr Wong had worked for the Government and a private property developer with extensive experience in property development and housing matters. Mr Wong was the Chairman of the Chartered Institute of Housing (Asian Pacific Branch) in the years 2003 and 2004. He is currently a member of the Hong Kong Housing Managers Registration Board and serving as advisor and member in the curriculum panels of a number of universities.

The HS Executive Committee extended congratulations to Mr Wong for assuming this management position and commended Miss Wong for her contributions to the Housing Society throughout the years.
