

跨代「商」連・青年創業計劃

背景資料

InterGEN Biz-net · Youth Start-Up Programme

Background Information

Hong Kong Housing Society actively encourages youth entrepreneurship. We fully support the second phase of the Well-Being \cdot Start-Up 2.0 Programme initiated by the Hong Kong Housing Authority, while striving to build an inclusive and harmonious community across different generations, including the elderly, middle-aged, youth and children. To support this goal, HKHS has launched the "InterGEN Biznet \cdot Youth Start-Up" Programme, offering four designated retail premises located at Healthy Village and Ka Wai Chuen to young entrepreneurs for a one-year operating period.

Selected participants will be exempted from paying rent and management fees during the first seven months of the lease. In addition, they will receive support for basic shop renovations and marketing promotion. If a participant earns a net profit during the programme, HKHS will collect 20% of the net profit as a fee. For the remaining months of the first-year lease (months 8 to 12), the rent will be calculated at 10% of the business turnover, in support of the programme's long-term sustainability.

Eligibility

- 1. Individuals
- Applicants should be 18 to 35 years of age and must hold a Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card
- Bonus points will be given to joint applicants comprising both young people and the elderly (aged 60 or above) to encourage intergenerational collaboration
- 2. Organisations
- Organisations that support and promote youth development are encouraged to nominate youth teams to apply
- Eligible organisations must be registered in Hong Kong, and their profits should be reinvested into businesses related to youth development or intergenerational harmony objectives.

Major Selection Criteria

Criteria include innovation of the business plan, feasibility and financial arrangements, social impact, market potential and team management, etc. Participants who promote intergenerational inclusion through their business or engage the elderly in their operations will receive additional points.

- 2. Selected participants must apply for business registration for their business operations in accordance with the Business Registration Ordinance (Cap. 310).
- 3. Selected participants are required to submit regular business and financial reports to HKHS every two months.
- 4. Selected participants must provide the required supporting documents (e.g., copy of Hong Kong Identity Card, proof of address, copy of business registration certificate, etc.) as requested by HKHS.
- 5. Selected participants may operate their business in the allocated store for a duration of 12 months. HKHS will regularly review the participants' business performance. If a store is found to be operating unsatisfactorily, remains closed for an extended period or encounters other unsatisfactory conditions, HKHS reserves the right to require the participant to cease operations and return the store to HKHS.
- 6. If the selected participants make net profits from their business during the first 7 months of the Programme, HKHS shall be entitled to charge 20 percent (20%) of their net profits ("Fee"). For the remaining period of the first-year lease (months 8 to 12), the rent will be calculated at 10% of the business turnover to support the development of the Programme.
- 7. The Fee will be calculated based on the management accounts of the business of the selected participants and payable by the selected participants on the date which is [30] days from the earlier of (i) the end date of the first-year lease of the Programme and (ii) the date the relevant selected participant ceases to participate in the Programme (the "Termination Date"). Selected participants shall within [14] days from the Termination Date deliver to HKHS updated management accounts of their business covering the period up to and including the Termination Date for HKHS's review and

- calculation of the Fee. The calculation of Fee by HKHS shall be final and conclusive, save for any manifest error.
- 8. HKHS will regularly review and assess the performance of the selected participants during the operation period. Those who perform well may be offered a one-year tenancy renewal at a discounted rental rate.
- 9. Participants perform well may also be invited to set up a rent-free kiosk/ pop-up store in the upcoming flagship shopping mall of HKHS in Kai Tak, as an opportunity to expand their business.
- 10. HKHS reserves the right to terminate the operation at anytime with reasonable notice to the participant.
- 11. Upon selection, participants grant HKHS a license to use the intellectual property rights of the relevant photos and/or videos. - c. the disqualification is necessary to protect the public interest, public morals, public order or public safety of Hong Kong.
